**Sojourners for Women:** A shelter and recovery center that can host 16 women recovering from heroine and meth addiction and in addition helps families to stabilize the family structure. They specializes in treating the whole woman through physical, behavioral and spiritual health.

**Jacobs Ladder:** This outreach is a way to "Pay It Forward" by providing backpacks filled with food for children over the weekend. Their mission is to eliminate hunger one child and one family at a time with hope and give dignity to all Preble County residents.
