Everyone has received by mail information on the **2020 CENSUS.** Forms need to be completed online or by US mail. The census data impacts everything from redistricting and the number of Congressional seats your state receives, to the billions of dollars that need to be allocated to over 100 federal programs serving your communit ies. These programs include: community mental health services, school lunch programs, highway construction, and federal Pell Grants. After May 13th census workers will come to homes that have not filled out the census. (read more-page2)
