Many of you and your local UMW units have generously given to our Miami Valley UMW Campership fund. Now we are ready to find those children or youth that would love to go to camp, but may be unable to do so because of the cost. Here's what you can do:

Encourage and sponsor a child (or children) or youth to attend Mission u or one of our three West Ohio UMC Camps: Camp Wesley in Logan, Ohio, Camp Otterbein in Bellefontaine, Ohio or Camp Widewater in Liberty Center, Ohio.

Application Process:

- 1. Identify potential campers.
- 2. Obtain Miami Valley United Methodist Women campership application form and UMC camp or Mission u brochure.
- 3. Choose a suitable camp for each camper.
- 4. Determine the amount of money the family, local UMW and/or your

Church, and West Ohio Conference camp scholarships can contribute toward the fees.

- 5. Fill out the Miami Valley District United Methodist Women campership application and the West Ohio Conference Mission u or Camp registration form.
- 6. Send completed request to the Miami Valley District United Methodist Women's Campership Oversight Board by **April 18**.
- g. Scholarship money will be sent to the local unit treasurer by April 30, so camp or Mission u fees can be paid.







The book and the scripture it uplifts, has been giving us new perspectives on old stories. Our faith has been strengthened and stretched as we have been challenged to take action to serve and raise our voices in support of others.



Deb Dunlop who serves on the Friends of Wesley team on the Miami Valley District, has prepared two documents for us to use so that we can continue to learn and serve. One document gives us information on Human Trafficking and the *Oasis House* in *Dayton*, it is <u>HERE</u>.
